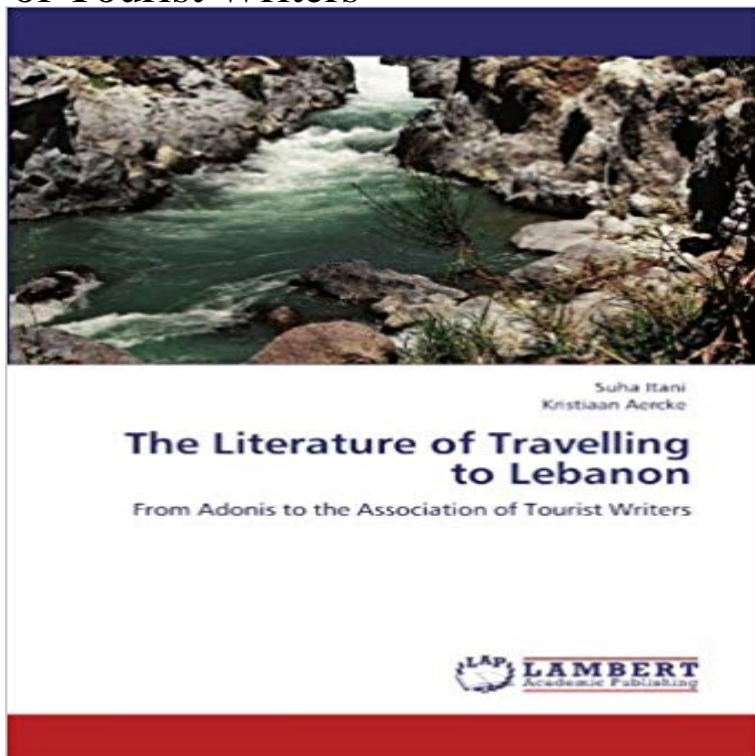


The Literature of Travelling to Lebanon: From Adonis to the Association of Tourist Writers
