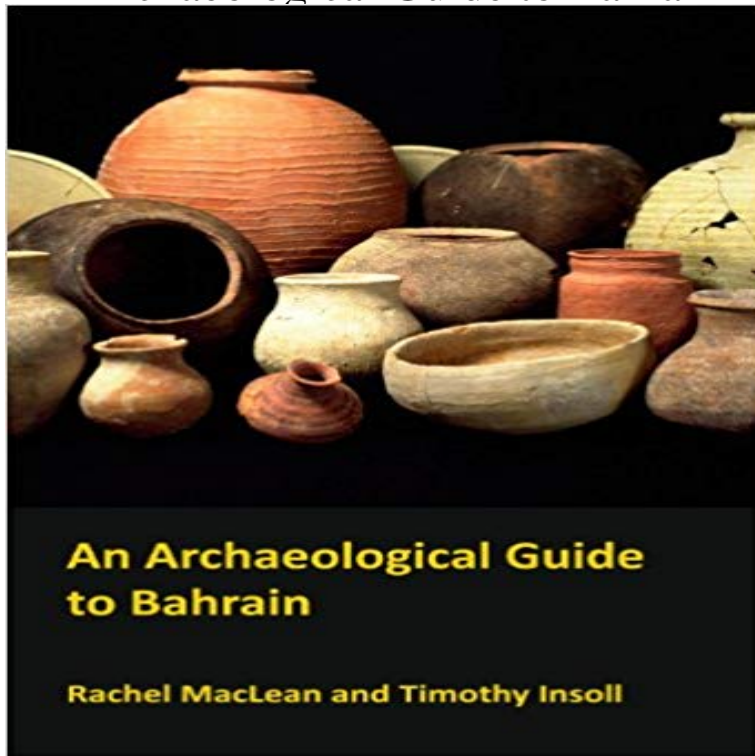


# An Archaeological Guide to Bahrain
