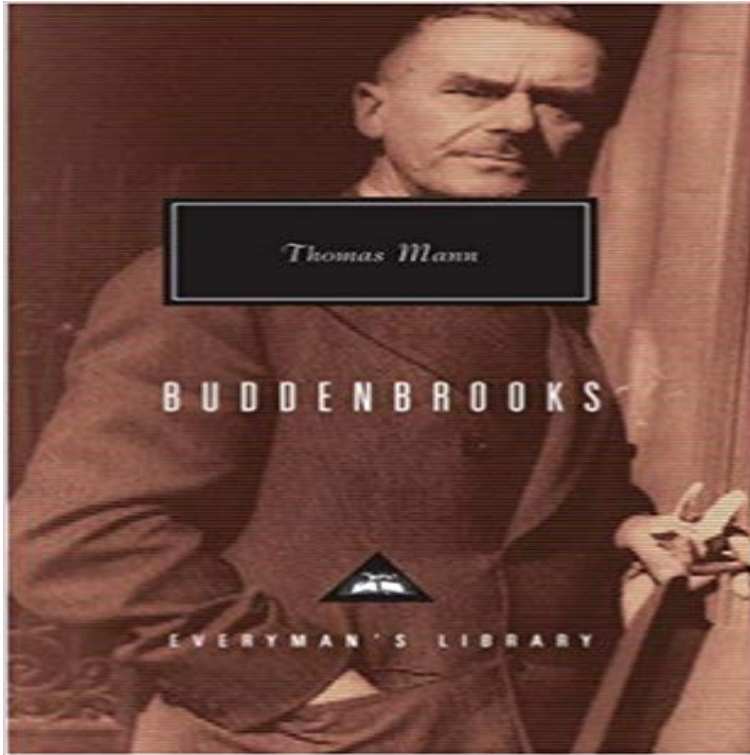


Buddenbrooks: The Decline of a Family (Everymans Library)
