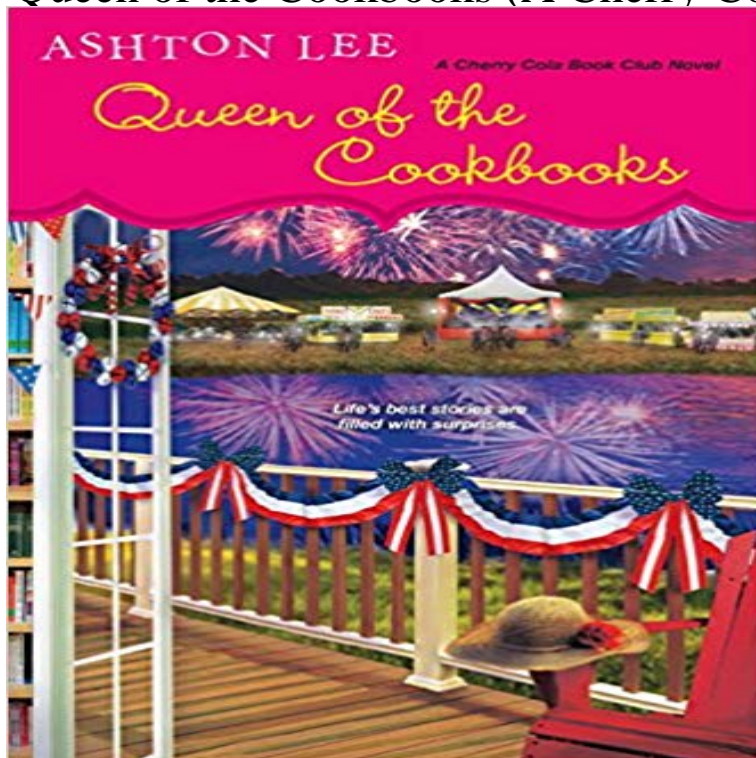


## Queen of the Cookbooks (A Cherry Cola Book Club Novel)
