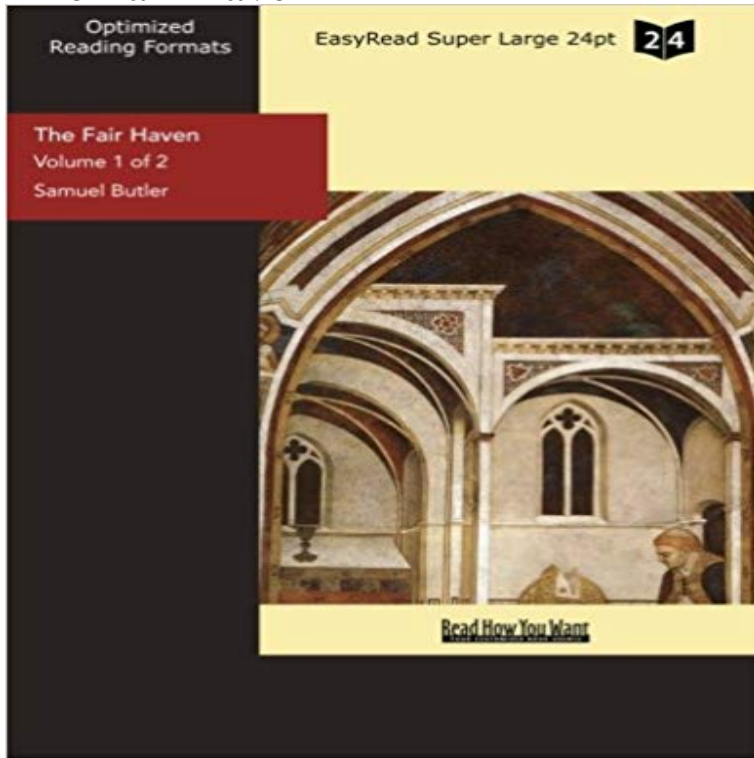


The Fair Haven
