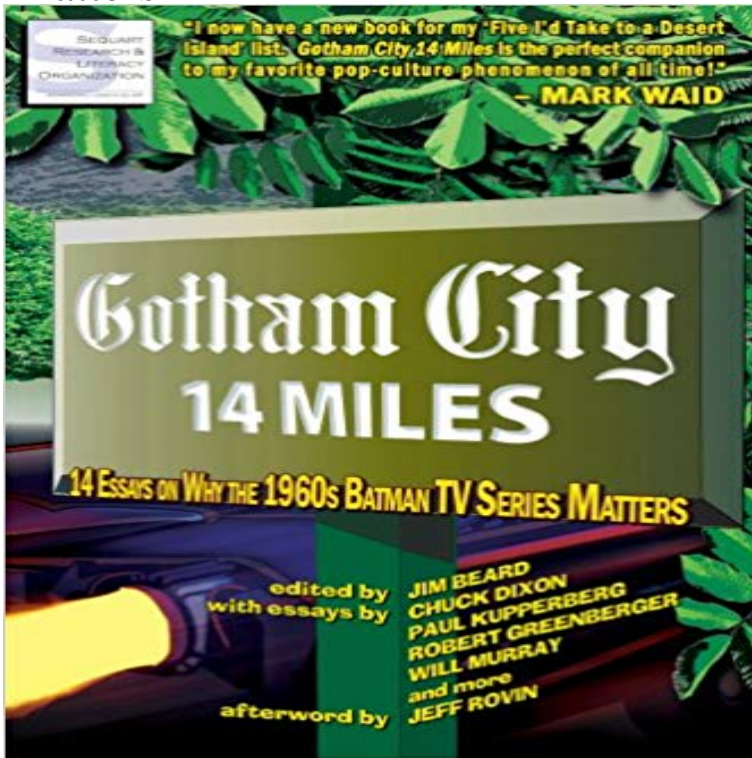


Gotham City 14 Miles: 14 Essays on Why the 1960s Batman TV Series Matters
