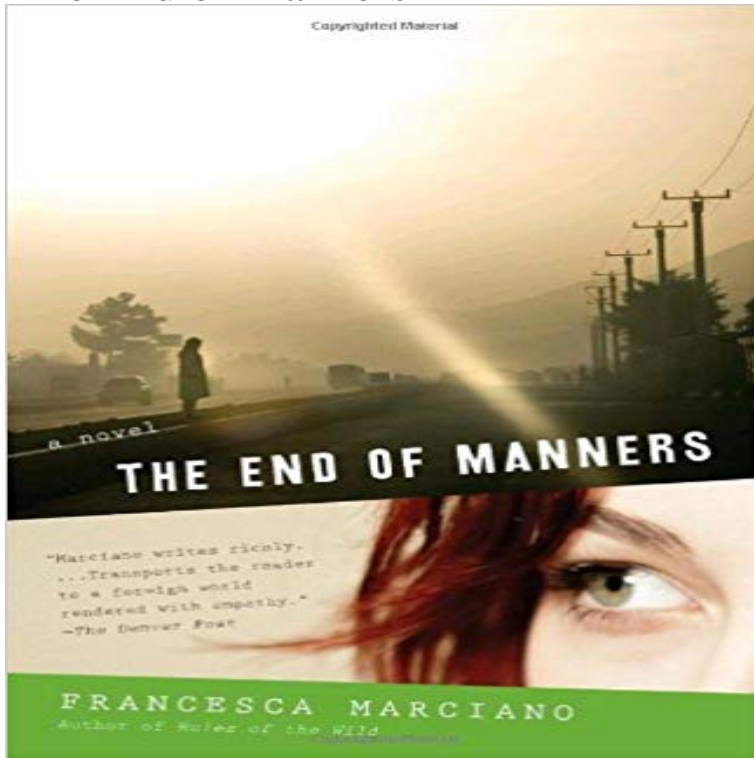


The End of Manners
