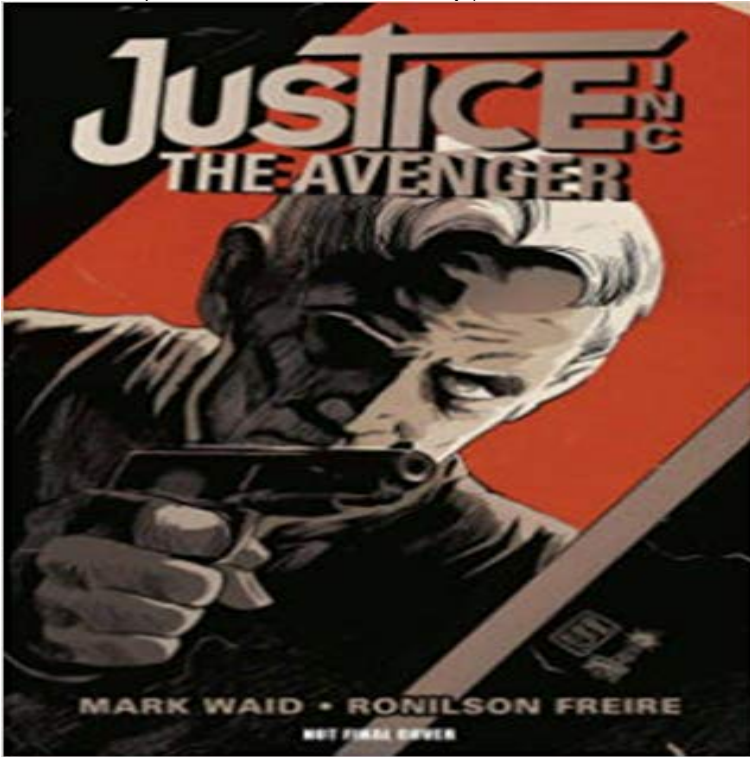


Justice, Inc.: The Avenger
