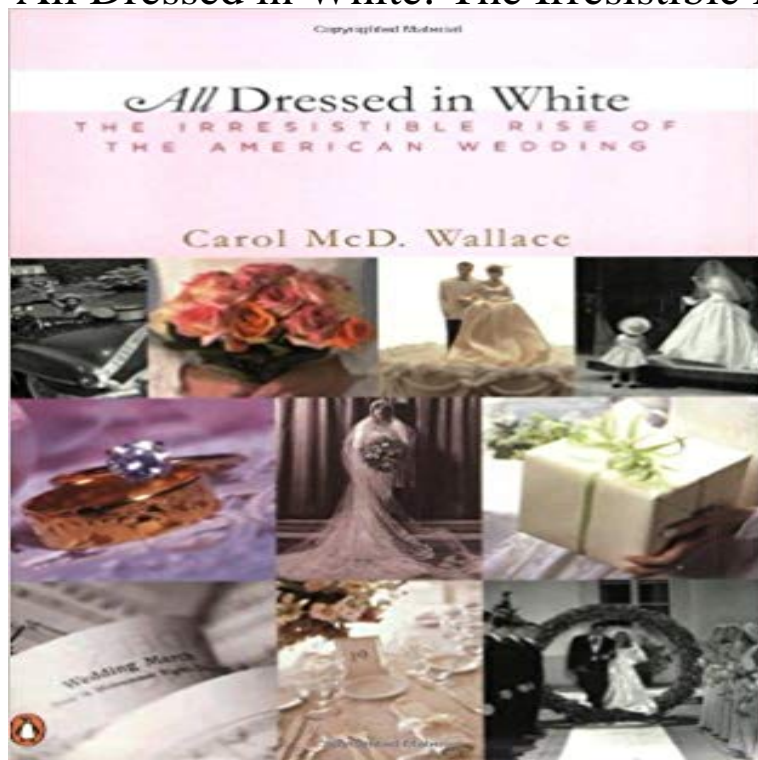


All Dressed in White: The Irresistible Rise of the American Wedding
