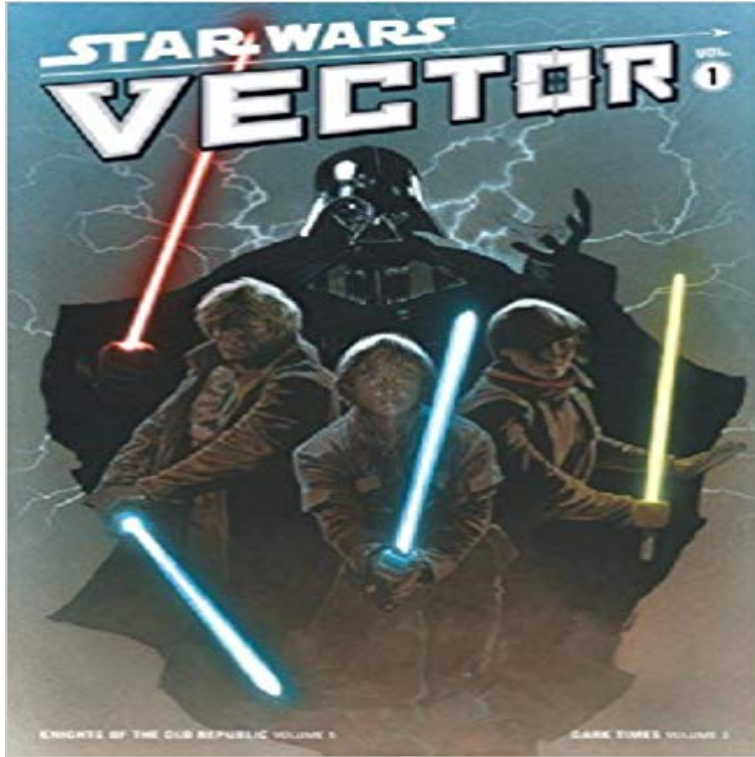


# Star Wars: Vector Volume 1
