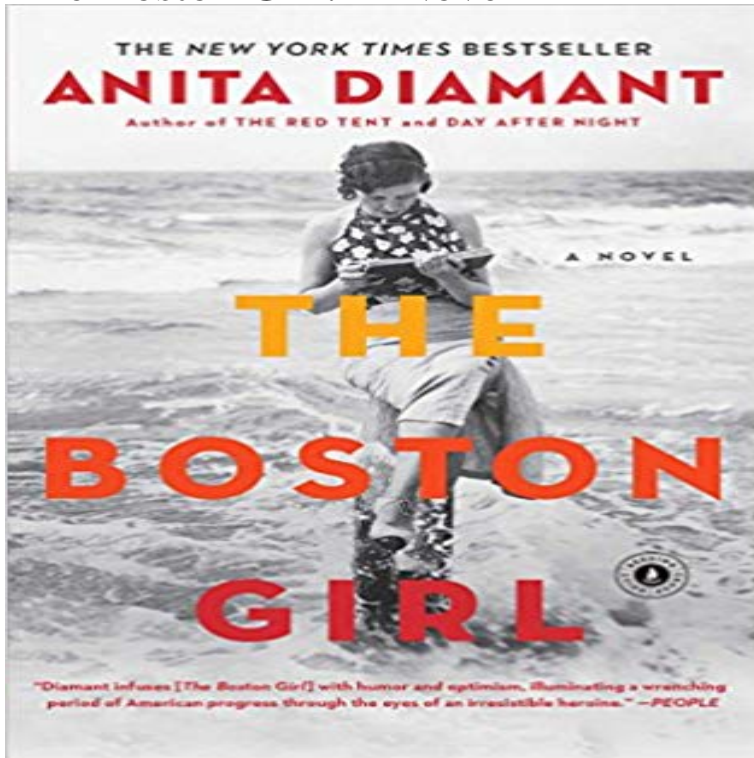


The Boston Girl: A Novel
