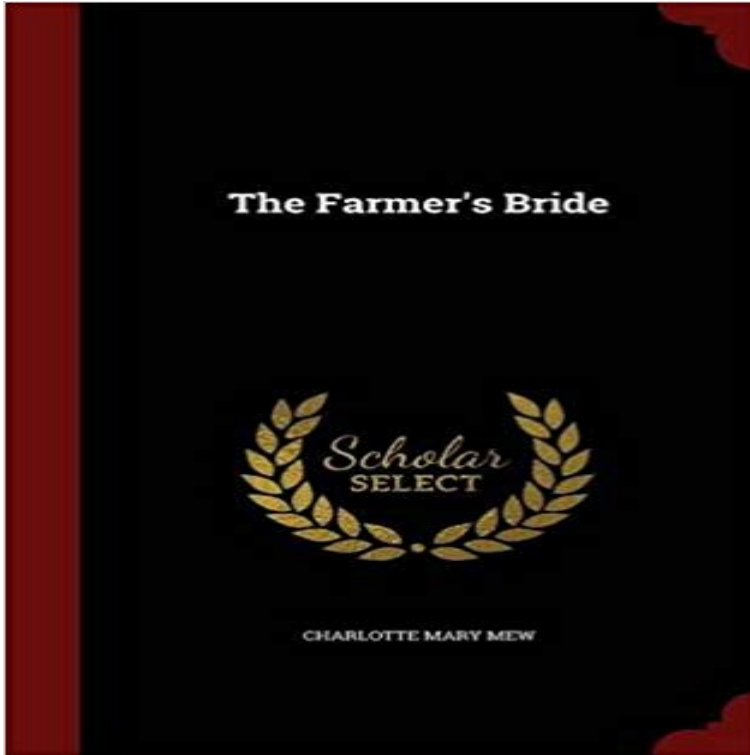


The Farmers Bride
