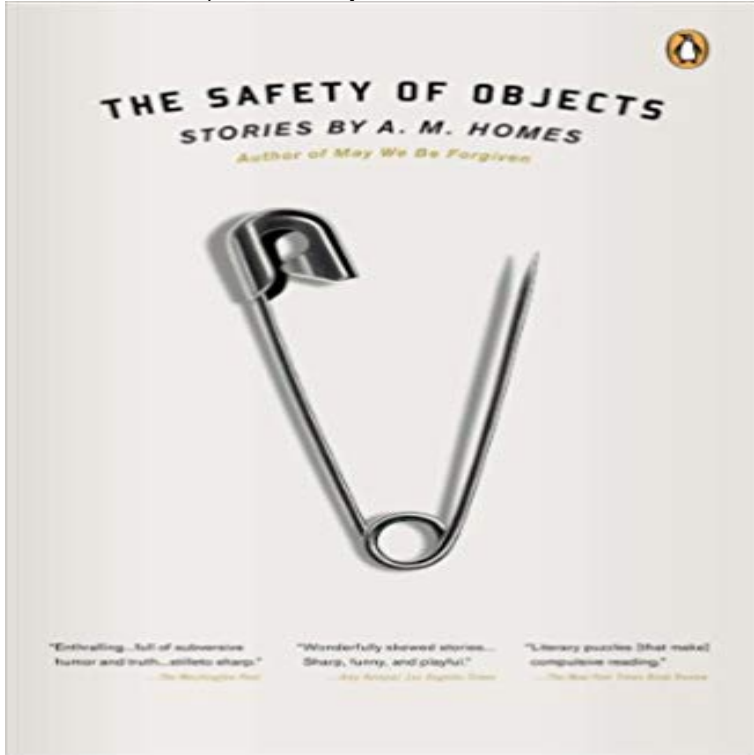


The Safety of Objects: Stories
