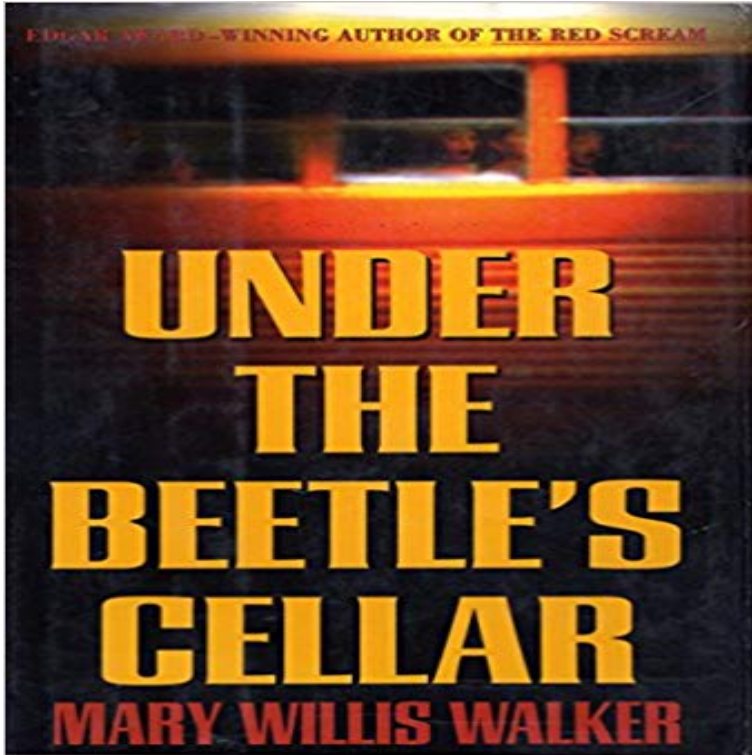


Under the Beetles Cellar
